Whether your child is just starting school or preparing for adulthood, Scouting provides a safe, inclusive environment where they can explore their interests, develop life skills, and make lasting memories.



Cub Scouts is a fun, hands-on program for boys and girls in kindergarten through fifth grade that builds character, teaches responsibility, and encourages adventure. Through age-appropriate activities like camping, STEM exploration, games, and service projects, Cub Scouts learn important values while having fun with friends and family. The program is designed to support both individual growth and teamwork in a welcoming, inclusive environment.



Scouts BSA is a youth-led program for boys and girls ages 11-17 that builds leadership, outdoor skills, and character through adventure and service. Scouts plan their own activities—like hiking, camping, and community service—while working toward personal goals, earning merit badges, and advancing through the ranks. The program emphasizes responsibility, teamwork, and preparedness for life.

The Eagle Scout Award is the highest rank in Scouts BSA and a nationally recognized symbol of leadership, service, and achievement. To earn Eagle Scout, a Scout must demonstrate strong character, earn a set of required merit badges, serve in leadership roles, and complete a significant community service project. Fewer than 10% of Scouts achieve this prestigious honor, which represents years of dedication and personal growth.
